## Frequently Asked Questions Full Teen Course

### **How it works:**

This 16-day class will allow teens to get their learner permit and prepare them with safe driving techniques before they begin their driving practice sessions. Students must attend the first 3 days to be eligible to take the permit test. Once students pass the permit test and receive their learner permit from the DPS, they can start their driving sessions.

### **Can I make payments on the Full Course?**

A \$200 deposit will reserve their spot in class. All downpayments are due by the first class day, however spots are limited and fill quickly. The remaining balance is due before the last class day.

### **What if they miss a day?**

Teens are allowed to miss a total of 5 class days. Missed lessons can be made up during the next course offering.

### **When can teens start driving?**

Students can begin scheduling their 7 driving sessions after receiving a learner permit from the Department of Public Safety (DPS).

### **How long does a teen have to complete the classroom and driving sessions?**

Teens will have 6 months from the first class day to complete all classes, make ups and driving sessions.

## Frequently Asked Questions Classroom Only

### **How it works:**

This 16-day class will allow teens to get their learner permit and prepare them with safe driving techniques before they begin their driving practice sessions. Students must attend the first 3 days to be eligible to take the permit test. Students in the Classroom Only Program will have to complete all 16 Days before receiving the certificate for a Learner Permit.

### **Can I make payments on for Classroom-Only?**

A \$150 deposit will reserve their spot in class. All downpayments are due by the first class day, however spots are limited and fill quickly. The remaining balance is due before the last class day.

### **What if they miss a day?**

Teens are allowed to miss a total of 5 class days. Missed lessons can be made up during the next course offering.

### **When can teens get the permit?**

After passing the permit test and completing all 16-days, students will receive their certificate to obtain a learner permit from the Department of Public Safety (DPS). Teens can begin driving practice at home, but must sign up for Parent Taught to complete the driving portion of the drivers ed program.

### **How long does a teen have to complete the classroom?**

Teens will have 6 months from the first class day to complete all classes & make up sessions.
